Brooks Public Library Overview 2003-04

Quick History

Since it's inception in 1951, the Brooks Public Library has undergone a number of changes from its once being housed in the Brooks Rest Room to its current home in the former headquarters for the Eastern Irrigation District. In 1993 the building was purchased by the town and was then expanded to approximately 7,500+ sq feet in size.

The Stats

Our Collection - includes books, pamphlets, compact disks, magazines, newspapers, cassettes, kits, CD-ROMs, Videos, DVDs, and databases - was 48,738 by the of 2002, grew by 5.5% in 2003 to 51,577

Check it out, check it in - was 118,415 circs by the end of 2002, grew by 2.8% in 2003 to 121,827 - 13,117 sent to other Shortgrass libraries, 7,335 came to our patrons from other Shortgrass libraries. As of November 3, 94,211 items had been circulated for 2004.

Cardholders - 1,893 residents and 153 non-residents in 2002, 1,832 residents and 129 non-residents in 2003, a decrease of 3.2% - but things are looking up as current figures have increased again to 1,963 residents and 109 non-residents as of October 2004.

Through our doors - in 2002 just over 62,000 people visited the Library, last year this number rose to 63,006, and so far this year 55,442 have come through our doors at the Library.

Computer lab uses - was 10,816 by the end of 2002, grew by 13% in 2003 to 12,480. We have five computers available for the public to use for research, email, resume writing and internet surfing.

Programming sessions – last year we had 3,948 people come out to our various programs ranging from basic computer sessions to author visits to class tours. This year the number is has risen to 4,562 and this was primarily due to the Medieval Faire held in late May.

The Basic Facts

At present the library is open 54 hours a week, 302 days a year.

Resident individual cardholders pay \$12.00 per, resident families pay \$18.00, non-resident individuals pay \$60.00 and families pay \$80.00. Residents include those living in County of Newell Divisions 1, 4, 5, 6 and 10.

The Library employs one head librarian, two full time staff, and five part time staff. We also take advantage of youth employment granting opportunities and hire a Summer Program Coordinator as well as a computer assistant when such opportunities present themselves.

Staff Volunteerism 2004

Last year it was estimated that staff members spent a total of 360 hours volunteering for various library related activities.

- 1. Staff members take books to shut-ins and seniors after library hours.
- 2. Preschool Story and Toddler times, as well as other programming activities are, often, prepared by staff at home. This entails the selection of stories, preparation of crafts, as well as the organization and purchase of supplies and treats.
- 3. Much of the time spent preparing for this year's Medieval Faire was done with volunteer assistance of staff members and members of the public.
- 4. The preparation and organization of special events such as fundraisers as well as the participation in these events are also done after hours.
- 5. For the period of a month, staff members sort mail at the provincial building at 8am each work day as we make use of the government courier for the transferal of materials between libraries outside the Shortgrass system.
- 6. During lunch hours breaks a staff member goes to both the post office and the provincial building to pick up library mail.
- 7. Materials to be recycled are taken to the depot after work hours.

Building Maintenance 2004

On behalf of the Brooks Public Library Board, and Staff I would like to offer thanks to the Town and to Terry and his crew for the service they have provided this year.

I met with Terry Walsh during the summer months to discuss various maintenance issues. A tour was done on the interior and the exterior of the building. Here are the issues as well as updates:

1) Minor maintenance issues

- a) Seal around the outer entrance doors was replaced.
- b) Garbage receptacle is now located at entrance of building.
- c) New signage has been installed around interior.

2) Temperature inside building

A humidifier was mounted above the magazine section in the spring and over the late summer/early fall a new boiler system was installed. All the pipes were cleared out and the heat seems to be working well.

3) Lighting

Currently the lighting around the exterior of the building is in working order. Kelly recently replaced all broken bulbs.

4) Graffiti and vandalism

Graffiti has not been a problem this year but vandalism continues to be an issue as we had two of our large windows smashed in late June. These were promptly replaced by the Town and we have not had any major incidents of vandalism since.

5) Signage

We would also like to ask the Town to continue considering the possibility of placing additional library signage along 2nd St. and/or Cassils Rd. leading up to our facility.

6) Cleaning interior

In recent months, the cleaning of the interior of the building has not been consistent. Terry has looked into this matter and some improvements have been made.

7) Painting

Terry has informed me that some painting may be done in the building in the coming months. We need to coordinate times as the library is open 54 a week and it will be difficult to do the work when we are open.

8) Carpeting

There are plans to re-carpet a portion of the floor space in the library. The areas chosen will most likely be the well worn, high traffic areas.

Mid Year Review 2004

Over the past eight months, the Brooks Public Library has seen various changes, challenges and successes come to pass. This review is intended to provide our stakeholders, the Town of Brooks and the County of Newell, with information on what has taken place this year at the Library.

Governance and Board Changes

In December 2003, long time Board members, Jonathan Jaikaran and Rudy Esau both finished their terms of nine years. Since the beginning of 2004, three new members have been appointed by the Town of the Brooks to the Board. Tilly Gamble-Altwasser, Dino Champlone and Karen Nelson have all signed on for a period of three years and the Board is pleased to welcome them.

The Policy Standing Committee of the Board has been working on revising several policies as well as Board By-laws. With the addition of new sections and schedules, the By-laws have undergone a complete reworking to better reflect the Library's daily operations.

The Library's Collection

All areas of the Library's collection continue to grow with additional resources. So far a total of 2,369 new items have been added to the Library's collection this year including materials in children's and adult fiction, large print, adult non-fiction, CDs, magazines, and the reference section. As the collection increases changes need to be made for better access to materials and over the past half year, the children's fiction collection was completely re-categorized. Needless to say, parents of small children are very pleased with the change.

Cardholders on the Rise

At this time last year the Library saw a fairly dramatic downturn in the number of residents and non-residents purchasing library cards. This year, however, we have seen a steady increase back to pre-2003 numbers, with the number of current cardholders standing at approximately a hundred more over last year at this time.

Programming Highlights

To encourage and increase library patronage, the Library has continued to offer a number of well attended programs to Brooks and County of Newell residents. Over the past year the library has hosted exhibits by local artists such as Rita Wildschut and Pat Neufeld, and well known provincial artists including Alex Janvier and Bill Laing. With a generous grant from the Canada Council for the Arts, the Library was also able to host Canadian authors Gloria Sawai, Faye Reineberg Holt, and Ann Alma. As in previous years, the Library held it's "Around the World in 29 Days" series of lunch box talks given by people who come from all parts of the globe and now reside in Brooks. Library users also had an opportunity to sharpen their internet skills with help from our CAP sponsored Internet Assistant. And our 2004 Summer Reading Program and Family Fun Events were extremely popular again this year. Both Story Time and Toddler Time

Thirty years ago the Brooks Public Library shared the upper floor of the Town Hall with the Court Room. Today, of course, the facilities of all three have been greatly enhanced. The Library probably has the choice location as a buffer between the downtown core and Evergreen Park. With lots of trees and lots of parking, it is a great place to spend time. The earlier Library had dozens of books and a collection of magazines equal to the typical doctor's waiting room. Now there are thousands of books on the shelves and access provided to millions more. There is a fine assortment of current newspapers and magazines as well as a room of computers with internet access. As well, it is the center for heritage and cultural presentations.

I have made great personal use of the library over the years. At one time, I drove a truck for night deliveries and always took along an audio cassette book.. Our children all had library cards and we would visit it regularly. Since my retirement, 3 1/2 years ago, I have made a visit to the library to browse through the newspapers and magazines a regular part of my daily ritual. Although I seldom check books out, anymore, many times I have made use of the technical and research sections to solve problems and to find information. While at the library I have observed many students (youngsters and adults) working on their school work. Experts seem to agree that a good study environment is a key to success at school. Many homes do not provide that kind of environment, but the library does. Even if the students only use their own texts, the library provides the right environment.

I have also noticed a great interest in the computer room of the library. There is often a line up and the librarians must encourage patrons not to exceed their share of time. I do not know if these computers are being used for research or for e mail, but either way they are very popular and serving a community need.

I am trying to say how much I appreciate our Public Library with its serene atmosphere, multitude of information and polite and helpful staff.
