



Brooks Public Library is now accepting resumes for a temporary, 35 hours/week, position of Advocacy and Community Needs COORDINATOR. Position begins May 2nd, 2022.

Responsibilities for this 10 week position include conduct library tours, distribute summer reading program registration materials, and assist the Library Manager with the Community Needs Assessment Project.

Only applicants aged 15 to 30 will be considered as funding is provided by the Canada Summer Job Grant. Ideally, the position will be filled by a post-secondary student of a Library Information studies program, but priority will be given to an outgoing individual with demonstrable familiarity with the Brooks Community.
