

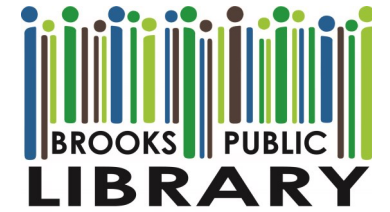


Brooks Community Adult Learning Council Wednesday, April 26th @6:30pm
