

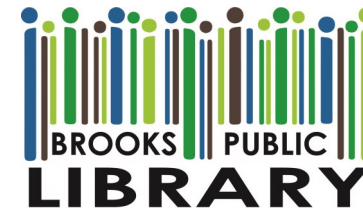
4-H: Learn To Do By Doing Wednesday, August 17th @6:30pm

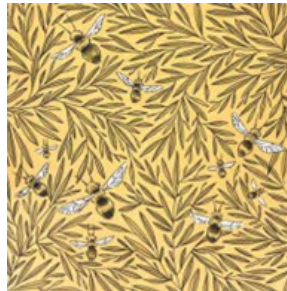
