**NFB Film “John Ware Reclaimed.”**

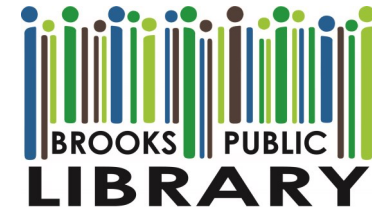
**Saturday, February 17th 1pm-3:30pm**

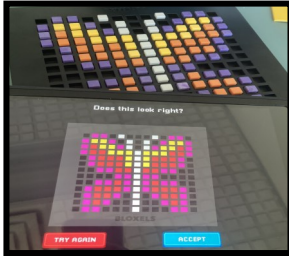

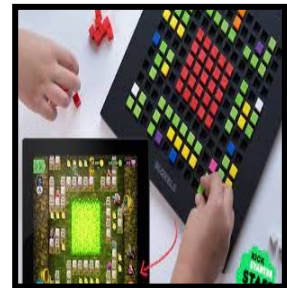

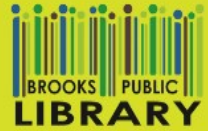
