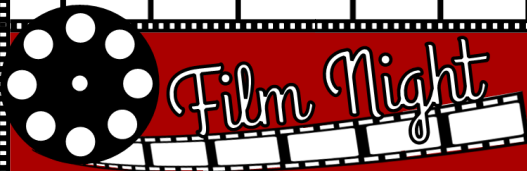
Treat yourself to a mystery-wrapped book or some locally made goodies and help support the Library!

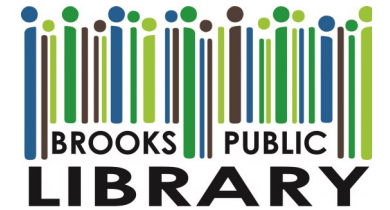

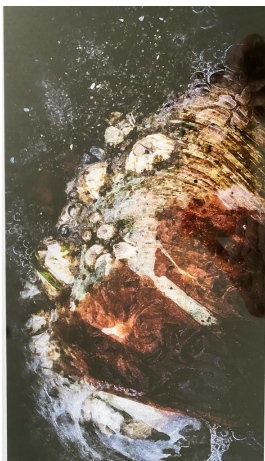
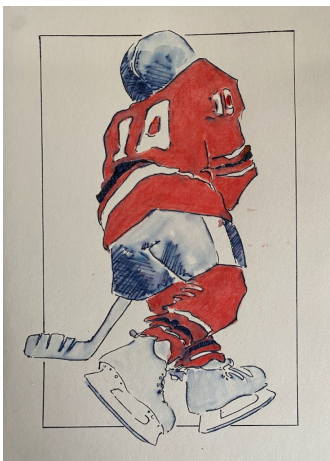
