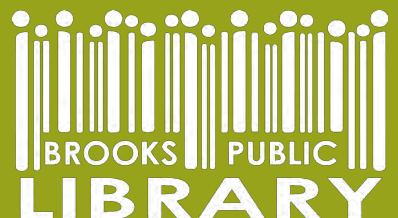

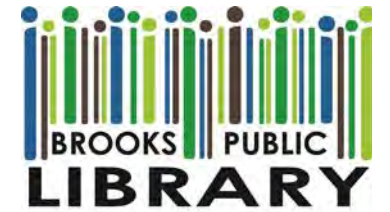

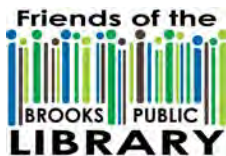
Celebrating Canada's Asian Heritage Month
