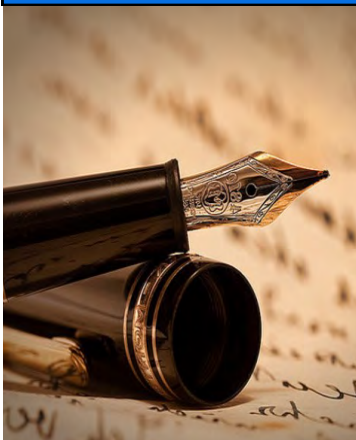

Thursday, November 28th @6:30pm

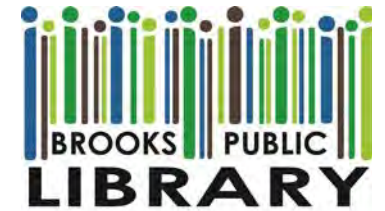
Come to the library to hear from local authors Linda Penner and Pam Robertson as they discuss their literary careers.

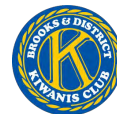

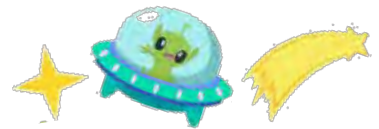
