College Basics With Medicine Hat College

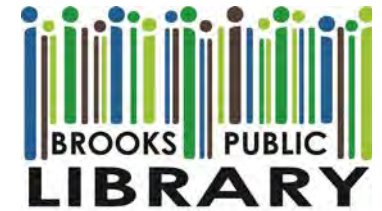
