This is a free, drop-in program.

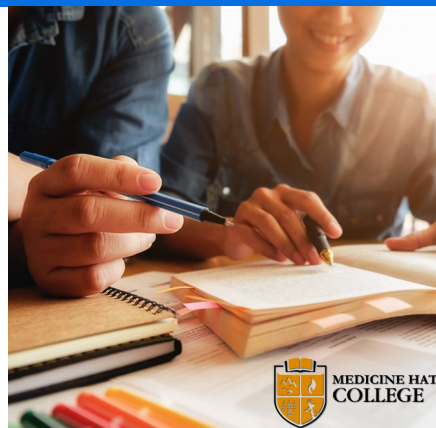


College Basics with Medicine Hat College
