Shortgrass Library System is looking for a part-time Driver for a fixed term of one (1) year. The successful candidate will provide courteous and efficient pick-up and delivery of library materials between 14 member libraries in Southeast Alberta and the Shortgrass Headquarters office in Medicine Hat.

This is a part-time position with hours ranging between 12 and 16 total hours per week (approximately 2 delivery days each week).

The position will also fill in for other Shortgrass drivers when they are absent.

As a Driver, you will be responsible for:

- Loading and unloading boxes of materials from the vehicle.
- Making deliveries in the Shortgrass Library System region.
- Performing repetitive tasks with excellent attention to detail.
- Sorting, packing and unpacking of library materials into boxes and into the vehicle.
- Lifting cargo up to 50lbs.
- Maintaining cleanliness of vehicle and reporting maintenance problems to supervisor.
- Working effectively without direct supervision.
- Driving assigned route in all kinds of weather and road conditions.
- Booking maintenance appointments and bringing vehicle to appointments when required.
- Practicing safe driving habits and adhering to all applicable traffic laws.
- Following all Shortgrass COVID-19 Safety protocols, including masking.

The ideal candidate for this position should:

- Be at least 25 years old to meet insurance requirements;
- Have great communication and customer service skills;
- Exercise excellent judgement;
- Be able to interact successfully with both clients & co-workers as part of a skilled customer service team;
- Be able to perform heavy lifting: Must be able to lift/carry up to 50 lbs;
- Excellent time management skills;
- Be able to perform frequent bending, twisting, kneeling and squatting;
- Be able to perform frequent reaching over shoulder, waist level, and from the floor;
- Have completed a High School Diploma or equivalent;
- Be in possession of a valid class 5 Alberta Driver's License and a clean driver's abstract;

• Be able to provide a clean criminal record check, including vulnerable sector check.
