CHANGES TO ALBERTA'S EMPLOYMENT STANDARDS

On January 1, Alberta's updated *Employment Standards Code* went into effect. The updated

standards include significant changes and additions to almost all aspects of the code, including regulations around leave, rest periods, wages, and youth employment. Additionally, changes have also been made to the standards governing the administration and enforcement of these laws. including a new penalty system for employers who violate the code.



The Shortgrass Library Board is also reviewing and updating its own internal policies to ensure

that they meet these new standards. More information about this will be made available to library managers and staff as these changes are put into practise.
