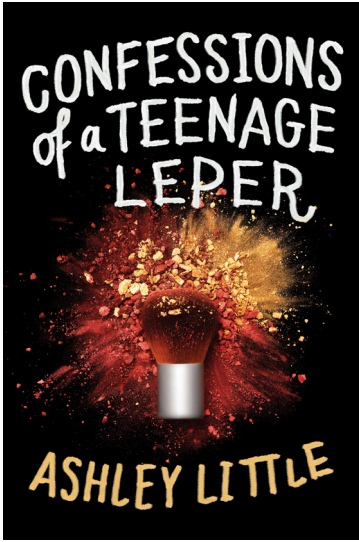
TIC-TAC PRESENTS: MUSIC MIX NIGHT

Saturday, October 5, 10:00 am - 5:30 pm

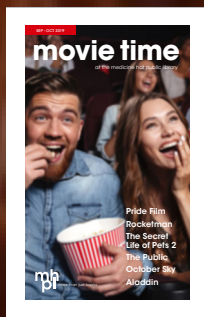
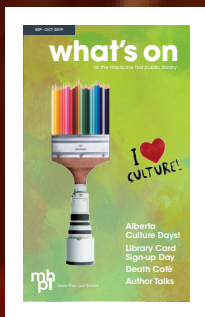
